

- Proven Stability with Mature Release History
- Over a dozen major releases in 10 years with highly robust quality control, QA, beta's, etc. (Example FreePBX 13 was 12 months of Alpha and Beta with over 15000 installs before going to stable/GA)
- Although it's open source, Sangoma invest millions of dollars every year in R&D into this software and writes almost all of the code (a small minority comes from the community)
- Staff of 20-25 people working on the project in different fashion
- A lot of features and roadmap is driven by the community
- Transparent with all Source Code online and full Bug and Feature tracker



How does FreePBX Benefit you


- Enables you to partner with Sangoma (Sponsors and Stewards of the open source Project)

 - 4-6 Upgrades per year of features and bug fixes
- Most common FreePBX Commercial Modules included
- Streamlined GUI



Product Family – Summary of a few Key Features

- Power over Ethernet Simplify cabling
- Full duplex speakerphone Great voice quality
- Dual Gigabit Ethernet ports with built in switch
 - Only a single Ethernet cable per desk is required
- Built in 5-way conference calling
 - On the fly, no need to schedule conference bridge
 - Limited to 3 in most phones
- HD voice Great voice quality
- VPN client built-in built in security for remote users



Summary of USPs, Key Selling Features

- Single vendor for complete solution PBX + phones
- Designed for FreePBX
 - Plug and play deployment with Endpoint Manager
 - Built-in phone apps
 - E.g. call flow management, queue management, presence, etc
 - Zero Touch Provisioning
- Native VPN client for secure connections
 - Great for remote users



Easy Provisioning with EndPoint Manager

EndPoint manager included with Sangoma phones



- Control global settings
- Program phone keys
- Map extensions to MAC addresses and templates
- Upload images
- Download new firmware
- Scan for non-provisioned phones







Auto Provisioning

- Phones are complex to install
 - Many, many parameters
- With 100s of extensions manual configuration would take hours
- Endpoint manager takes care of this:
 - Use global templates for office wide settings
 - Program phone from PC rather than via phone UI







Full Integration with Phone Apps

- Control complicated features directly from the phone
 - No need to remember feature codes
 - No need to login to PBX control panel to control features




Zero Touch Provisioning

Redirection server redirects to the FreePBX system using the unique <deploymentID.pbxact.com>



Built in VPN

- VPN client included in phone
- Allows remote users to securely and easily access office based PBX
 - No need for VPN router at SoHo
 - Traverse firewalls
 - Easy for remote users to setup
 - No other device needed
